<u>VENUE</u>: - Bob Robinson Park – 60 Kyle Street, Rutherford (Maitland MCC MX Park) Access to venue is available from 1.00Pm Friday.

<u>RIDERS BRIEFING:</u> A horn will sound as a 4 minute to start signal for riders briefing. <u>Riders Briefing is a NON Smoking Area</u>.

RACE FORMAT:

There will be ONE track– Enduro track section will change on Sunday. There may be some additional changes that will be notifies to riders.

SATURDAY & SUNDAY – Enduro Cross (weather permitting) – there will be as many races as possible, some classes may be combined. Riders will have a one lap pre ride (sight lap) immediately prior to their first race.

- Should dry conditions force the track to be deemed too dusty, the format will revert to block sprint &/or double lap sprint.

WALKING OF TRACKS:

Riders may walk Saturday's course after 1.00pm Friday - you will be notified at riders

briefing regarding walking Sunday Course.

No riders may enter the course without the permission of the Clerk of Course after racing has started. *** There will be an escorted sighting lap for all riders prior to their 1st heat of racing – the sighting lap is not compulsory – it is the riders responsibility to enter the sighting lap within 3minutes of the sighting lap starting or entry to sighting lap may be denied **

SIGN ON: Riders must bring their MA Licence and Logbook to sign on. Riders and/or parents will be asked, at sign on, to sign a declaration confirming they will attend riders briefing (a random check will be made at briefing). As per Supp Regs riders and parents will also be asked to sign a contract to participate (indemnity).

<u>SCRUTINEERING</u>: Don't be late. All competitors are asked to present their bikes and helmet and armor at Machine Examination. Bikes will be scrutineered to ensure they comply with the current GCR's. Each rider may have scrutineered a 2nd motorcycle at a cost of \$20, payable at scrutineering. There will be an additional scrutineering Sunday morning 7am - 7.15am or at the discretion of Clerk of Course.

<u>NUMBERS:</u> All Number Plates **and numbers** on all Machines MUST comply with the current GCRs. <u>ANY BIKE THAT DOES NOT HAVE THEIR NUMBER CLEARLY DISPLAYED ON ALL 3 NUMBER</u> <u>PLATES WILL BE ABLE TO PURCHASE NUMBERS FOR \$25.00</u> – Electrical tape and/or texta will not be permitted – Any refusals will deny rider entry without refund.

<u>COURSE</u>: Each course has been marked with their distinctive arrows & bunting.

Two arrows adjacent on the course are GATE course markers ie Riders <u>MUST ALWAYS</u> pass between these arrows. Riders MUST stay on the "intent" of the course. No Deviation will be accepted.

STARTS & START ORDER:

Start Procedure will be mass start with possible combined classes.

Race order will be posted prior to the event.

Grid Positions will be 1st in best dressed for the 1st heat then pick of the grid for subsequent heats. The Clerk of the Course reserves the right to seed riders into the start order for the purpose of safety before and during the event.

CHANGE OF MOTORCYCLE:

Change of bike rule: Change of Bike rule for Sprints shall apply to this event - See Supplementary Regulations section 12

REFUELLING

There will be an open refueling area – riders may refuel back at their camp / vehicle. All motorcycles must be fitted with a removable cap (no fast fuellers). All tanks must be standard or accessory tank up to 12 litres. RIDERS MUST NOT SPEED IN THE FUEL CONTROL.

Riders must dismount, engine must be turned off and enviromat under bike prior to refueling.

During the event - ALL REFUELLING AREAS ARE NO SMOKING & NO ALCOHOL AREAS Closed footwear must be worn - no thongs & pushbikes are NOT permitted.

FIRE EXTINGUISHERS:

EACH RIDER MUST Supply a minimum 1KG Powder Fire Extinguisher at their refuelling area.

FOOTWEAR AND PUSHBIKES: In all areas:

Between the hours of 7am & 4pm Saturday and 7am & 2pm Sunday there is to be NO pushbikes, NO smoking, NO alcohol and NO open footwear (no thongs).

<u>HELMETS AND DOUBLING:</u> Helmets <u>MUST</u> be worn at all times by any person on a motorcycle whilst at this venue. Doubling on motorcycles is <u>NOT</u> permitted unless both persons on the motorcycle are **entered in the event** and wearing helmets.

<u>CAMPING</u>: Camping will be available Friday & Saturday nights at the track. The track gate will open at 1pm Friday. Cost of camping is **\$20** per vehicle/family.

Camping fee **MUST** be paid at sign on (if not paid with entry) and a sticker will be issued for each vehicle **If Camping Fee not paid at sign on the camping fee will be: \$50.00 per vehicle**

- There are toilets & water but no electricity.
- There is mobile phone coverage at the venue.
- Campers will be allowed individual campfires if they are responsible and cautious. A fire extinguisher MUST be readily available at the fire
- Please leave access road clear and be considerate of other campers.
- Riding though camp area at idle (1st Gear) speed only NO MOTORBIKES ARE TO BE RIDDEN OR STARTED AFTER 6pm!
- Directions issued by the camping official MUST be adhered to by all persons
- There is a 7pm curfew on all persons under the age of 18. After 7pm all persons under the age of 18 MUST be in the company of their parent or legal guardian at all times.
- <u>There is a 6pm bike curfew and a 9pm noise curfew</u>. No motorcycles are to be ridden or started after 6pm. No noise what so ever after 9pm, including but not limited to generators and loud voices. There are houses in close proximity and we need to respect the property owner's neighbours.
- All campers are to report any problems to the camping official. Photo and video evidence would be appreciated.
- Any person found to be breaching the camping regulations shall be evicted from the camp site, refused camping at all other venues and may have a penalty imposed up to exclusion.
- Adult riders are reminded they are responsible for their family and service persons.
- Bikes MUST NOT leave the camp area PLEASE RESPECT the property.

TRANSPONDER HIRE: Transponders will be available for collection on Saturday at Sign on.

Transponder brackets will not be hired – brackets will be for sale at sign on for \$15.00 please ensure you bring the correct money.

Please ensure you bring cable ties in order to secure your transponder & bracket to your motorcycle.

ENVIRONMENTAL:

All service crews must clean up their area before they leave.

TAKE ALL YOUR RUBBISH HOME WITH YOU – if bins provided are full.

TEAR OFFS ARE BANNED

ENVIRO MATS must be used when refueling –Enviromats in 2016 MUST measure 1m x 1.6m and be of approved absorbent material, <u>rubber backed</u> carpet is acceptable. Enviro mats available for sale \$15.00 at sign on.

<u>WASHING OF MOTORCYCLES</u> – Motorcycles can be washed at the track at the designated wash down bay only.

<u>CANTEEN:</u> Maitland MCC will be running a canteen from Saturday 6.30am till finish of racing Sunday with plenty of hot food & hot and cold drinks. Please support the local community and show your appreciation for all their efforts.

LOCAL COMMUNITY

Please support the local community as we rely on their positive feedback to council for our track licence.

<u>PRESENTATION</u>: will be held on Sunday for the event (both rounds) as soon as possible after racing. Riders must attend presentation in order to be entitled to any awards.
